RESOLUTION

PARISH OF ST PIERRE DU BOIS

5th April 2023

The ratepayers and electors of the above parish assembled this day by virtue of the Publication dated 30th March 2023.

1. Have approved the accounts of the Treasurer of the Parochial Cemeteries Committee, which have been duly audited.
2. Have approved the Constables' accounts, which have been duly audited.
3. Have approved the accounts of the Parish Procurers, which have been duly audited.
4. Have approved the sum of £108,593.76 to cover the cost of Household Refuse collection and disposal for the year from 1st January 2023 to be levied by means of Refuse Rate.

5. Have voted in favour of levying the following amounts by means of Owners Rate:-

a) Ordinary upkeep of Parochial Cemeteries:	
(i) Gardening contract	£23,352.00
(ii) General Maintenance	£2,150.00
b) Parochial Administration	
(i) Ordinary upkeep of other Parish Properties	£39,450.00
(ii) Administration, Clerical and Legal Expenses	£43,300.00
c) Cost of publishing Parochial Notices	£4,600.00
d) Street Lighting	£600.00
e) Public Needs to be approved by the Parish:-	
(i) Grant to La Houquette Primary School Library	£450.00
(ii) Grant to La Mare de Carteret High School Library	£350.00
(iii) Grant to Floral St Pierre du Bois	£2,000.00
(iv) New Post Office Planters	£585.00

6. a) Have authorised the Constables to apply to the Royal Court for permission to levy the above sums by means of the Refuse Rate and Owners Rate;

b) To decide that the said Owners Rate, together with that approved at the meeting convened by the Rector and Churchwardens, shall be levied applying the relative factors (as approved at the Ratepayers Meeting on 11th March 2009)

7. To transfer to Reserve Fund in accordance with the Parochial Taxation (Reserve Funds) (Guernsey) Law, 1997, as amended £10,000.00

8. To take all such measures relating to the above as the Ratepayers and Electors may deem advisable.

9. Have heard a parishioner request details of amounts in the *compte d'amélioration* which accounted for the community plan and liberation event.

10. Have heard a parishioner

State that the traffic element in the community plan included a pathway through his garden.


11. Have heard a parishioner ask if the Dazaine were in favour of Les Cochets planning or not
